

GUIDELINES TO AUTHORS

The Indian Journal of Landscape Systems & Ecological Studies (IJLS & ES) is an interdisciplinary journal devoted to the study of environment, both physical and cultural, and is bi-annually published in every June and December with ISSN: **0971-4170**. The articles not conforming to the following guidelines may not be considered for publication.

- ❖ Correspondence regarding publication of paper(s) should be made to the Hony. Editor, IJLS & ES by E-mail only: editor.ilee@gmail.com. **Please check website before submission for latest regulations.**
- ❖ Original contributions in the form of research papers, scientific articles and book reviews of contemporary interest on earth, environment, planetary and human sciences are invited from serious researchers. In principle, preference may be given to the young scholars and joint authors publishing as group. Each contributor will get a copy of the journal. However, processing fees and costs towards redrawing of the figures/ maps and printing of colour pages will be charged at cost price collectively for each paper.
- ❖ The paper should be submitted in electronic format only, typed (Font: Times New Roman (TNR) and double line spacing) entirely in English using transliterations or scientific names for colloquial multilingual terms and species names in Italics. The paper must suitably have the following specifications: Title of the paper in Capitalized Each Word Case, Bold (TNR- 14), and a running title within 60 characters including space must be provided.
- ❖ The Name(s) of the author(s) along with current affiliation (for ret./ex-students the last affiliating institution) having institutional address and PIN codes, Name of the Corresponding author and email ids of each authors must be clearly stated.
- ❖ The paper should have an Abstract (within 200 words), 3 to 5 keywords, the main text (TNR-12) may be subdivided into i) a brief Introduction with review of the previous works and statement of the problem, ii) Objectives in paragraph format, iii) Materials and Methods, iv) Results, v) Discussions, vi) Concluding remarks, Acknowledgements if any and vii) References.
- ❖ The pertinent References (in latest APA style: <https://apastyle.apa.org/style-grammar-guidelines/references/examples> only) used in the text are to be listed alphabetically. Online materials must be suitably referred with the complete URL and date of accession. Bibliography is not required. The reference should be provided as text only for editing if required.
- ❖ Length of the paper usually must not be more than 3000 words or should not exceed 15 printed pages including all.
- ❖ All headings and sub-headings should to be written in Bold, as the case may be, in 'Upper/Lower Cases' without Colon (:). Use bold and italics wherever needed for **Section Headings**, *Subheadings* and *Sub-Subheadings*.
- ❖ In case of units only metric system should be used. The units must be written as sq.km. and not km² (no superscripts). There should be no foot or end notes. Special characters should be inserted from symbol gallery of MS-Word documents.
- ❖ Table headings (e.g. **Table - 1: Table Name in Capitalize Each Word Case**) to be mentioned above the tables. Figures include Maps, Diagrams and Photographs (e.g. **Fig. 1: Figure Name in Capitalize Each Word Case**) must be properly captioned, numbered, and appropriately referred within the text. In case of photographs, the date of capture, person taking the photo and the location must be mentioned. Diagram Headings should not be within the figures but mentioned below the figures. For both tables and figures, the sources should be clearly declared, (eg. *Source: District Census Handbook, Name of District, Vol._ Part-_ pp.*).
- ❖ All maps should have proper legends, scale and coordinates. Figures must be self-explanatory with labelling or annotations. Tables should be submitted in editable format. All secondary materials must have proper permissions and details of original sources mentioned to avoid copyright infringement. The tables, figures, maps and plates in coloured format should be used in cases of absolute necessity. The same information should not be used in table and figure format. It is advisable to avoid inclusion of photographs. These must be original and legibly reproducible, to be submitted also as separate editable files (in .jpeg or .tiff) of higher resolution (not less than 300 dpi).
- ❖ Unless the paper is invited, each contributor must be a Fellow of ILEE. The Editor/ Editorial Working Committee (EWC) or ILEE shall not be responsible for the views expressed in the paper, any kind of infringement to copy rights, and/or violation of academic ethics will be the sole responsibility of the author(s) of the respective paper.
- ❖ A certificate from the corresponding author with a declaration that there is no conflict of interest, the paper is based on original research work and has not been submitted/ will not be submitted elsewhere till a decision is received from the office of the Editor, IJLS & ES for publication, needs to be submitted with the manuscript.
- ❖ Acceptance of the paper is subject to assessment by the peer reviewers and the editorial advisory board. The editor has the reasoned discretion to accept/ reject a paper or to include it in any other volume of the journal. All decisions will be communicated to the corresponding author at appropriate time.
- ❖ Copyright of the paper will rest with the author(s) concerned, but for its reproduction elsewhere, if necessary, the author(s) must take prior permissions from ILEE.
